

COVID-19 policy of Wrexham Muslim Association.

(Updated 13th July 2020).

- See Risk Assessment document.
- Friday congregation Salah will remain suspended until later stage.
- Shaikh Omran will kindly continue to deliver khutbah online.
- Daily congregational Salah will take place in the mosque three times a day instead of five.
- Timings of Salah will be **'Fajar' Jamaat, 'Dhuhr' Jamaat and 'Maghrib Jamaat'** according to Wrexham sunset time.
- Mosque doors will be opened from 30 mins before Namaz times till 30 mins after and remain closed at all other times. **Asr and Isha Jamaat** will follow shortly after Dhuhr and Maghrib respectively.
- **No more than 15** people allowed at one time.
- Only the **lower mosque hall** will be open.
- Ladies section will remain closed.
- Attendees to do Wudhu at home and bring their **own prayer mats, masks, shoe bag.**
- Keep **entrance doors wide open during Salah times** to avoid touching door handles.
- All attendees must wear **cloth mask** inside the mosque.
- All attendees must maintain social distance of **2 meters** from each other at all times including during jamaat.
- All attendees to **enter details** - name / email/ mobile number at each attendance.
- People **over the age of 70 and those in high risk group** due to medical conditions (as listed in Public Health Notices) are advised not to attend the mosque.
- People with COVID like symptoms (**fever, cough, sore throat, loss of taste or smell etc**) should not attend mosque.
- No food or drink allowed in mosque premises.
- Arabic School remains closed except **Quranic classes** with limited attendance.
